Welcome & Opening Remarks

Davin Suggs, FAC's Director of Public Policy, gave the following updates:

- FAC Legislative Days are March 27-28, 2019, in Tallahassee. Please [click here](#) for more information and to register. The legislative briefing will occur on Wednesday, March 27th and the FAC Water Policy Committee will have its first meeting on Thursday, March 28th.
- **SB 594 (Hutson) relating to State Shared Revenues** is a priority of FAC's going into upcoming committee weeks. The bill requires the Attorney General, at the request of one or more members of the Legislature, to investigate whether a certain official action of the governing body of a county or municipality violated state law or the State Constitution; requiring the Attorney General to report his or her findings and conclusions to the Governor, the Legislature, and the Secretary of State; providing requirements if no violation is found, etc.

FAC staff is scheduled to meet with Senator Hutson this week to discuss our concerns with the bill.
